HOW TO REGISTER

We have developed a dedicated registration page for the Developing Country Programme. The link to register will be shared with members individually. You will be able to register for the 24th World Energy Congress in 5 easy steps:

- Step 1:** Create your own registration account
- Step 2:** Upload all your contact and organisation details. **Note – you will be required to upload photo ID plus your passport details for security purposes.**
- Step 3:** Choose whether you wish to bring an Accompanying Person who can select from a selection of exciting tours, exploring the wonders of Abu Dhabi. **This is not included within your registration and is chargeable; the cost US\$800.**
- Step 4:** Individual participants covered by the Developing Countries Programme may select from a range of 4* hotels which they can book **free of charge** for up to 5 nights. Accompanying persons are chargeable.
- Step 5:** Book your flight. You can take advantage of the exclusive discount the 24th World Energy Congress have secured through Etihad Airways.
- Step 5:** Payment – if you have selected an accompanying person or flight, you will be asked to select your preferred method of payment – credit card or bank transfer.
